Registration Costs and Tournament Rules

- 1. Entry fee for persons fishing in the <u>ADULT</u> division is \$40. <u>This includes entry into Walleye and Northern divisions, &</u> <u>Mystery Fish.</u>
- 2. Entry fee for persons aged <u>13 and UNDER</u> fishing in the <u>JUNIOR</u> division is **\$25.** <u>This includes entry into Junior Walleye and</u> <u>Northern divisions, & Mystery Fish</u>
- There will be two EARLY BIRD DRAWINGS of \$50 each for two applicants whose entries are received on or before April 19th, 2025.
- There will be unlimited entries with <u>PAYOUT TO THE TOP 20</u> <u>PLACES IN BOTH SPECIES,</u> trophies awarded to the top 3 of EACH species in the <u>ADULT</u> division.
- Cash Payout is 80% in BOTH species and will be determined by the number of entries minus tournament fees and expenses.
- Prizes (only) in BOTH species will be awarded to the top 3 in the JUNIOR division.

- Place 1 fish per bag (provided at each weigh in landing) with water. Participants must register their own fish. Fish are subject to complete inspection by tournament officials, & their DECISION IS FINAL! Fish must be alive & in good condition. Dead fish will not be weighed in. Registered fish will be RELEASED by SBFDF-appointed personnel only,
- Pool 9 regulations have a protected slot limit of 20-27 inches for Walleye. Walleyes within the slot limit are to be released immediately. No Walleyes 20-27 inches long from Pool 9 will be weighed. ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 10. Weigh-ins will be located at the Municipal Landing, 1700 Marcou Dr, La Crosse (Pool 8-La Crosse), Stoddard Public Landing (Pool 8-Stoddard), and the Dairyland Landing (Pool 9-Genoa).
- 11. Scales open at 8 AM. Fish are eligible and will be weighed if you are in the weigh-in line at 3 PM SHARP. A spotter will mark the last eligible boat. You must weigh fish at the scales via boat in the water.
- 12. WALLEYE: Winning fish are determined by weight, length, and time fish is weighed
- 13. .NORTHERN: Winning fish are determined by weight and time fish is weighed.
- 14. To be an eligible participant, entries must be postmarked by May 12th. <u>Online registration ends at Midnight on May 12th.</u>
- 15. No hand-delivered entries or drop-offs will be accepted.
- 16. One fish of each species, per entrant in payout. You are allowed to register up to your daily bag limit of 15" Walleye, 15" Sauger, or 15" Saugeye, Northern. You must keep your copy of the weigh-in slip to be turned in for the top 20 payouts in both species to claim your prize.

- 17. No hand-line fishing allowed. You must use a rod, line, and hook. Both artificial and live bait are allowed.
- 18. Entrants aged 13 and under will automatically be fishing in the Junior Division.
- Both Junior and Adult division entrants must catch and register their own fish and must provide identification. Trading, swapping, or catching anyone else's fish for registration is prohibited.
- 20. Only tournament fishermen are allowed in the boat during tournament hours. 7 AM.to 3 PM.
- 21. The fishable waters of the Mississippi River for this tournament are **Pools 8 and 9 ONLY.**
- 22. Participants are not allowed to fish, occupy, or otherwise attempt to fish any water after 7 PM the day before the tournament.
- 23. Participants must fish from a boat launched at a WI-approved landing site. No lowa or Minnesota Landings are permitted. No shore, dock, or float fishing is allowed. Legal transport of any fish for weigh–in is via boat only.
- 24. <u>YOU ARE REQUIRED TO LAUNCH YOUR BOAT FROM A WI PUBLIC</u> <u>BOAT LANDING IN POOLS 8 or 9. THIS IS TO FACILITATE THE</u> <u>INSPECTION OF YOUR BOAT BY TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS BEFORE</u> <u>YOU LAUNCH. LAUNCH TIME IS 1 HOUR BEFORE START OF THE</u> <u>TOURNAMENT. YOU MUST STAY IN SIGHT OF THE LANDING UNTIL 7</u> <u>AM (Legal fishing time).</u>
- 25. Participants are required to pay any boat landing fees.
- 26. Officials reserve the right to check/observe participants before and on the day of the tournament for compliance with rules. Credible evidence indicating violations of these rules or DNR regulations, or boat launch fees can result in forfeiture of prizes and disqualification from this event.
- 27. It is required that all participants display a blaze orange colored ribbon. The ribbon is to be tied to the boat and visible from all directions by officials during the hours of 6 AM to 3 PM on the day of the tournament. Ribbons will be available to all participants free of charge at the following businesses: Tuna's Bar - Genoa, Stoddard Village Hall, Thirsty Turtle Bar - Stoddard, and ACE Hardware of La Crosse.
- 28. Spotters will be located throughout the tournament waters. We remind participants to abide by the rules to assure honesty, fairness, and, above all, sportsmanship. Failure to comply with state DNR regulations and/or these tournament rules will result in the forfeiture of any prize and **future participation**.
- 29. NO CARRY-INS on grounds. Remember this is a FUNDRAISER!
- 30. CANCELLATION POLICY: NO REFUNDS. In the case of high water, landing closures, unsafe water conditions, and at the discretion of the SBFDF Walleye Committee, the fishing portion of the tournament will transition to the "High Water Shindig" at a location TBD.
